  - Issue #1. Growth related to increased troops and families will exacerbate the challenges faced by local jurisdictions to provide already strained public safety and emergency services in the Fort Carson region.
  - Issue #2. Military-specific law enforcement and public safety issues are emerging as a concern and will increase as more troops are stationed at Fort Carson and return from deployments.
  - Issue #3. The large number of emergency service providers in the region requires substantial efforts to ensure efficient delivery of services and coordination between service providers.
