7. Provider Presentations -

A. Discover Goodwill. Ms. Kristen Amundson, Business Development, has been with Goodwill for 9 years and 7 years with MCC. She shared that Discover Goodwill is an open door program so riders can sign up if they meet the qualifications and do not need to be Goodwill clients. They provided 20,428 rides last year with services from 3AM-10PM. They support three day programs, however, with COVID the routes have been consolidated. They operate a Fleet Maintenance Division that is open to any commercial fleet.



B. City of Colorado Springs 2020 Rider Survey. Erin McCauley, Sr. Compliance Analyst, shared the survey is done approximately every three years. This year they were able to complete the Fixed Route survey between March 8-14, 2020 before the COVID shutdown. The Metro Mobility program was surveyed in June and had fewer responses due to COVID.
