1. Workshop Overview (5 min)

3. Scenario Planning – What, Why, and How? (10 min)

- What is scenario planning, why are we doing it, and how will we use the scenarios developed at this workshop?

4. Underlying Land Uses and Activity Centers (5 min)

- Description of the three underlying land use scenarios and the activity centers we have identified for population and employment in the Pikes Peak region.

5. Contributing Factors (10 min)

- Explanation of the list of contributing factors. Would the group like to add any factors?

6. Small Group Exercise (75 min)

- Groups have 15 minutes to discuss Underlying Land Use 1 and develop a “story” explaining the role of the contributing factors.
- Take 10 minutes for all groups to report what they developed for Scenario 1.
- Groups have 15 minutes to discuss Underlying Land Use 2 and develop a “story” explaining the role of the contributing factors.
- Take 10 minutes for all groups to report what they developed for Scenario 2.
- Groups have 15 minutes to discuss Underlying Land Use 3 and develop a “story” explaining the role of the contributing factors.
- Take 10 minutes for all groups to report what they developed for Scenario 3.

7. Next Steps and Wrap-Up (10 min)

- Staff will post a summary of the Scenario Planning Workshop on PPACG’s website and notify participants of its availability via email.
- The public will vote on a preferred “story” for each land use scenario at community events throughout the summer.
- Staff will take the draft scenarios to the TAC, CAC and Board of Directors in late summer/early fall for review and approval.
