A. Review By-Laws. Last discussed in June 2021. Ms. Laura Crews highlighted possible changes to purpose: expand to all mobility modes vs just human service and public transit only. Need to look at trip reduction opportunities to help with greenhouse



gas and ozone attainment. The Mobility Community does not look like the general population, so add a 3rd point regarding moving business people and tourists as well.

Meetings: currently noted for quarterly meeting, change to monthly or minimum of 10/year? Voting: Clarify Primary and Secondary members and voting vs non-voting. Chair Somers noted there is a definition at the end of membership but not here. Ms. Jolene Hausman, concerned providers might be less open if they know funders could vote on issues. Membership: does PPACG Board have to approve? Composition expansion, there are no appointed members from PPACG municipalities. Maybe look at county level only. Where are past funding organizations now? Planning entities are not included so no input on Safe Streets, yet City of COS is a planning entity. Expectations around attendance and absenteeism.

B. Review meeting topic ideas. Chair Somers shared work to get a Veterans funding panel for April to explain how veteran transit funding works. Additional ideas from The Independence Center public comments, ADA updates, day program demands, Mountain Metro and fixed transit work to meet future needs.

C. MMOF Prequalification Call: Ms. Laura Crews is available for questions. Projects must be vetted by CDOT. May 23rd will be presentations at the Divide Sheriff's Office.
