Provider Updates:

The Independence Center – partnering with Colorado Springs around route changes.

City of Fountain – partnering with Fountain Valley Senior Center to do paratransit for those over 60.

Community Intersections – working to expand routes, find drivers. Mr. Dick Hyde has been driving routes and this is his first time back in many months.

CDOT – 7/5/22 is the SuperCall Announcement. On site reviews are happening.

MedRide – looking to partner with organizations across all 3 counties.

FVSC – Sharon Brown will now be attending as the Board representative from Fountain Valley Senior Center.

Mountain Metro – Fixed route needs drivers. PACE is struggling to get busses. Ms. Kristen Amundson said Goodwill might be able to help.

SilverKey – 50% turnover of drivers. Doing wage adjustments and hired 3 PT staff. Awarded a MMOF 3 year grant.

MCC Purpose and Future Meeting Structure – Ms. Kristen Amundson recapped the purpose of the MCC:

- A. To advise and recommend to the PPACG Board of Directors and staff on current and emerging issues, goals, and plans for public and human services transportation in the Pikes Peak Region.
- B. Information sharing related to transportation issues, grants, best practices, education, and advocacy to provide maximum benefit to the Pikes Peak Region.
- C. Be the experts on transportation issues and best practices.
- D. Provide information and educational opportunities, training and/or tools, so that transportation may be integrated into all aspects of the community.

Maintain and promote a directory of services offered by members for the targeted demographic groups.

The MCC Executive Committee has been discussing the need to evolve MCC into a more working opportunity for members, less formal structure. Looking for opportunities to have operations staff attend and discuss programs. When there are times for more leadership level decision making, then those members would be invited. Ms. Laura Crews wants to see more collaboration among members so looking for discussion opportunities. CDOT will bring feedback from their provider visits. Ms. DeAnna Rumsey wants to recruit users of transit.

- a. Mobility Guide. It is completed and translated into Spanish. Electronic version available now on PPACG website.
- b. Needs Assessment update. Ms. Laura Crews is facilitating this for El Paso County. Focus areas include individuals with disabilities, caregivers, diverse populations, veterans. Focus groups will be conducted in July and August and she needs provider help to host and recruit. Funding is available to implement new service models that come out of this study.
- c. Tri-County Study update. This is completed and data is being compiled.
- d. CDOT Super Call. Out on 7/5.
