A. Mountain Metro on Fare Free August. Share September data. Mr. Jacob Matsen presented the following statistics

	Fixed	Paratransit
July	218,000	7883
August	302,883 (2% from prepandemic)	10,666
September	213,000	10,058

They did not see an increase in people who are homeless riding the bus. There is a 3 month free fare program available that the City may explore.

B. Envida presentation. Ms. Gail Nehls presented. Envida means “together in life.” They have a long history of service in the region and currently are serving a much broader demographic and geographic area. They acquired COACH Transportation in April and are moving to an on-demand model. They are tracking 220 denials since January. They provide Envida Moves (transportation) in El Paso, Park and Teller counties and Envida Home (homecare services) in El Paso and Teller counties.

C. El Paso County Needs Assessment Project Update. Barriers to on-demand transit. Ms. Laura Crews shared the presentation from the PPACG Board workshop. It addressed the various methods underway to identify gaps in transit, what the gaps were for rural and urban. Opportunities discussed included software needs both for provider coordination and rider access, on call drivers, VIA system in Boulder and Seattle.
